Living Proof Live Recap

I just returned home from the 2009 Beth Moore Simulcast held one mile and a half from my house. I hope never to miss another one as long as they are broadcast. I had never heard Beth Moore speak before and it only took this once to turn me into a lifelong fan. She is truly a precious voice of God - a light of God to us in these times of having to take a serious look at our lifestyles. Many of us are having to prune some of our "luxuries" we have been comfortably able to enjoy in past. This weekend, Beth gave us a bright new perspective on the desires of our heart.

Psalms 37: 1-9 was her text with an emphasis on verse 4. "Delight yourself in the Lord and He will give you the desires of your heart." The following are seven incredible insights regarding the aforementioned verse and a few inspirational statements to provoke much thought:

1. Nothing dictates our lives like our desires.
Not a temporary carnal craving. A true heart desire is a sustained longing unaffected by mood or surroundings.
2. Beneath the desires of our hearts is the heart of our desires.
Every desire implies something you lack.
3. Delighting in God adapts our desires into inevitabilities.
A man's delight is to feel pleasure or satisfaction.
God's delight is to incline to or to move towards.
4. Nothing external can steal our right to delight.
Most likely thieves of delight are jealousy, anger and worry.
She had some very enlightening teaching on these.
5. To make room for delight, we have to commit.
Are you down spiritually? That is because you will not come to a decision.
6. Nothing is passive about patiently waiting for your desire to turn into delight.
Waiting is defined by anxious expectation (on your toes trying to see it coming). Do something with the anxiety - turn it into praise!
7. Until faith becomes sight, trust God and do good.
Do is an action word. Do not settle for being right - go out and DO good for others. You have one chance at the land you dwell in - make a difference.

There were thirteen of us who attended the Simulcast and we unanimously voted it an awesome time in God's Word. Be prepared to see more opportunities to experience some of Beth Moore's Bible Studies in the near future.
