

## Trust in Jesus

Proverbs 3:5-6 (NASB)

Trust in the LORD with all your heart and do not lean on your own understanding. In all your ways acknowledge Him, and He will make your paths straight.

John 1:1-14 (NASB)

In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God. He was in the beginning with God. All things came into being through Him, and apart from Him nothing came into being that has come into being. In Him was life, and the life was the Light of men. The Light shines in the darkness, and the darkness did not comprehend it. There came a man sent from God, whose name was John. He came as a witness, to testify about the Light, so that all might believe through him. He was not the Light, but *he came* to testify about the Light. There was the true Light which, coming into the world, enlightens every man. He was in the world, and the world was made through Him, and the world did not know Him. He came to His own, and those who were His own did not receive Him. But as many as received Him, to them He gave the right to become children of God, *even* to those who believe in His name, who were born, not of blood nor of the will of the flesh nor of the will of man, but of God. And the Word became flesh, and dwelt among us, and we saw His glory, glory as of the only begotten from the Father, full of grace and truth.

John 18:38a (NASB)

Pilate said to Him, "What is truth?"

John 18:37b (NASB)

Jesus answered, "You say *correctly* that I am a king. For this I have been born, and for this I have come into the world, to testify to the truth. Everyone who is of the truth hears My voice."

John 14:6 (NASB)

Jesus said to him, "I am the way, and the truth, and the life; no one comes to the Father but through Me."

Micah 5:2 (NASB)

But as for you, Bethlehem Ephrathah, *too* little to be among the clans of Judah, from you One will go forth for Me to be ruler in Israel. His goings forth are from long ago, from the days of eternity.

John 7:42 (NASB)

Has not the Scripture said that the Christ comes from the descendants of David, and from Bethlehem, the village where David was?

Psalms 119:105 (NASB)

Your word is a lamp to my feet and a light to my path.

2 Timothy 3:16-17 (NASB)

All Scripture is inspired by God and profitable for teaching, for reproof, for correction, for training in righteousness; so that the man of God may be adequate, equipped for every good work.

Trust in His Redemption

Redemption means to buy out; free from the bondage of sin

Psalm 107:1-2 (NASB)

Oh give thanks to the LORD, for He is good, for His lovingkindness is everlasting. Let the redeemed of the LORD say so, whom He has redeemed from the hand of the adversary.

John 1:29 (NASB)

The next day he saw Jesus coming to him and said, "Behold, the Lamb of God who takes away the sin of the world!"

Isaiah 53:5, 12b (NASB)

But He was pierced through for our transgressions, He was crushed for our iniquities; the chastening for our well-being *fell* upon Him, and by His scourging we are healed. ...Yet He Himself bore the sin of many, and interceded for the transgressors.

1 Peter 2:24 (NASB)

...and He Himself bore our sins in His body on the cross, so that we might die to sin and live to righteousness; for by His wounds you were healed.

Trust and Obey Hymn

Trust in His Understanding

Understanding means insight, comprehension

Matthew 15:16 (NASB)

Peter said to Him, "Explain the parable to us." Jesus said, "Are you still lacking in understanding also?"

Acts 4:13 (NASB)

Now as they observed the confidence of Peter and John and understood that they were uneducated and untrained men, they were amazed, and *began* to recognize them as having been with Jesus.

John 16:13a (NASB)

But when He, the Spirit of truth, comes, He will guide you into all the truth;...

Trust and Obey Hymn

Trust in His Salvation

Salvation means deliverance from the guilt and the pollution of sin.

Luke 19:9-10 (NASB)

And Jesus said to him, "Today salvation has come to this house, because he, too, is a son of Abraham. For the Son of Man has come to seek and to save that which was lost."

Romans 10:9-10 (NASB)

...if you confess with your mouth Jesus *as* Lord, and believe in your heart that God raised Him from the dead, you will be saved; for with the heart a person believes, resulting in righteousness, and with the mouth he confesses, resulting in salvation.

Trust and Obey Hymn

Then in fellowship sweet  
We will sit at His feet,

Trust in His Eternal Life

Eternal life means a free gift from God and is a perpetual life that goes on and on and on, with no end.

John 3:16 (NASB)

For God so loved the world, that He gave His only begotten Son, that whoever believes in Him shall not perish, but have eternal life.

Ephesians 2:6 (NASB)

...and raised us up with Him, and seated us with Him in the heavenly *places* in Christ Jesus.

Acts 16:14 (NASB)

A woman named Lydia, from the city of Thyatira, a seller of purple fabrics, a worshipper of God, was listening (to Paul preach); and the Lord opened her heart to respond to the things spoken by Paul.
