5 Big Twists And Turns In Life

1. In Our Thinking

Acts 13:28-30 (ESV)

And though they found in him no guilt worthy of death, they asked Pilate to have him executed. And when they had carried out all that was written of him, they took him down from the tree and laid him in a tomb. But God raised him from the dead.

Luke 24:21 (ESV)

But we had hoped that he was the one to redeem Israel. Yes, and besides all this, it is now the third day since these things happened.

2 Kings 5:11 (ESV)

But Naaman was angry and went away saying, "Behold, I thought that he would surely come out to me and stand and call upon the name of the LORD his God, and wave his hand over the place and cure the leper."

2. In The Direction Our Life Takes

Exodus 13:17-18 (ESV)

When Pharaoh let the people go, God did not lead them by way of the land of the Philistines, although that was near. For God said, "Lest the people change their minds when they see war and return to Egypt." But God led the people around by the way of the wilderness toward the Red Sea. And the people of Israel went up out of the land of Egypt equipped for battle.

Deuteronomy 8:2 (ESV)

And you shall remember the whole way that the LORD your God has led you these forty years in the wilderness, that he might humble you, testing you to know what was in your heart, whether you would keep his commandments or not.

3. Through Betrayal In Our Lives

Psalm 55:12-14 (NIV)

Genesis 50:15-20 (NIV)

So they sent word to Joseph, saying, "Your father left these instructions before he died: 'This is what you are to say to Joseph: I ask you to forgive your brothers the sins and the wrongs they committed in treating you so badly.' Romans 8:28 (ESV)

4. Through The Loss Of A Loved One Or A Serious Illness

Romans 8:35-39 (ESV)

Who shall separate us from the love of Christ? Shall tribulation, or distress, or persecution, or famine, or nakedness, or danger, or sword? As it is written, "For

your sake we are being killed all the day long; we are regarded as sheep to be slaughtered." No, in all these things we are more than conquerors through him who loved us. For I am sure that neither death nor life, nor angels nor rulers, nor things present nor things to come, nor powers, nor height nor depth, nor anything else in all creation, will be able to separate us from the love of God in Christ Jesus our Lord.

2 Corinthians 1:8-9 (ESV)

Poor Choices

1 Samuel 26:21 (KJV)

Then said Saul, I have sinned: return, my son David: for I will no more do thee harm, because my soul was precious in thine eyes this day: behold, I have played the fool, and have erred exceedingly.

Psalm 38:5 (ESV)

My wounds stink and fester because of my foolishness.

1 Chronicles 21:8 (ESV)

And David said to God, "I have sinned greatly in that I have done this thing. But now, please take away the iniquity of your servant, for I have acted very foolishly."

Ephesians 2:3-4 (ESV)

...among whom we all once lived in the passions of our flesh, carrying out the desires of the body and the mind, and were by nature children of wrath, like the rest of mankind. But God, being rich in mercy, because of the great love with which he loved us,

1 John 1:8-9 (NIV)
